We invite you to attend the **55th Annual Phoenix Scottish Games on March 2nd and 3<sup>rd</sup>. 2019**. We hope that your clan or society will join us at **Steele Indian School Park** in central Phoenix for this special event. Please note the following important information, then submit a Clan Registration Form or register online:

- Tent stakes will be allowed except in areas near sprinkler systems, which will be marked in white. Please be prepared to set up without stakes if needed. Spaces are 15' x 15'
- You must be setup for the full day(s) of the event, in order to give all our visitors a good show.

- No electrical service will be available.
- Steele Indian School Park is a non-smoking facility.
- You may sell items related to your organization, or conduct a raffle, *from within your tent space*. Please note the "tax" requirements information on the registration form.
- Setup and Teardown access, as well as parking will be available (as prior years) on the grass just north of the Clan tent area. However there can be absolutely NO in-and-out movement during the event.
- We will have carts available to assist with setup and breakdown as needed
- Dogs are allowed in the Park as long as they are kept on leash at all times.
- There is no RV parking provided at the Park. There is a list of area RV Parks on our web site.
- Maps will be included with your confirmation package for Clan area setup, handicapped parking, general parking, and equipment drop off locations.

Please indicate any request you may have to be located alongside another Clan or organization. We will attempt to honor such requests to the best of our ability. **And be sure to let us know if your clan will have any special guests or dignitaries in attendance.** The Caledonian Society, at our discretion, will accord honors to individuals who hold a (inter)/national office in their clan or society. And of course to Clan Chiefs recognized by the Court of the Lord Lyon!

Each clan or society will be provided two tickets for each day for each space purchased. You may purchase additional tickets – being offered to Clans at last year's prices! The new host hotel will be the Grand Canyon University Hotel (and Restaurant) which is at 5115 N. 27th Ave. Phoenix. That's at Camelback immediately west of I-17. The Hotel and Restaurant are a hands-on learning environment for GCU students in the Hospitality Management program. It is about 3.5 miles or about 10-15 minutes from the Park.
